The aim of the Loudoun Symphony's education programs is to encourage community members to discover the power and beauty of live orchestral music and to motivate youth to learn an instrument and play in an ensemble, thereby carrying the skills and inspiration into the next generation.

To achieve these goals, we keep symphony concert admission affordable and encourage family attendance by offering free admission to youth 12 and under. A concert participation patch is available for youth groups. To introduce orchestral music and instruments to all ages, we offer Family Concerts, an Instrument Petting Zoo, and elementary school mini-concerts.

For those embarking on the adventure of making music, we offer performance opportunities through the Loudoun Symphony Youth Orchestra for ages 10-18, String Workshop for all ages, and Loudoun's Got Talent! for high school age students.

In the event the Symphony must cancel a concert, ticket purchasers may opt to receive a ticket voucher for a future concert or a receipt for a tax-deductible donation in the amount of the original ticket purchase. Subscribers and ticket purchasers may request a receipt for a tax-deductible donation in the amount of their ticket purchase if they return the tickets to the Symphony office at least 48 hours (two days) prior to a scheduled concert date.
